It is very important that parents complete an application for younger siblings to attend our school. As you are aware, all our classrooms are full and we have three portables on site. We have run out of classrooms and if you would like to ensure your child a place at Hillside Traditional in future year.

# Safety for Drop-off and Pick-up

Safety is of paramount importance to us at Hillside. Parents who use the loop, please remember to only drop off or pick-up your students from the flat area of the loop and not on the hill. As the pavement gets wet or freezes, it can become very slippery for both cars and students. Also remember that on dark and rainy days, it is difficult to see children at the crosswalks. Please refrain from parking in the crosswalk or the bus stop. These areas are clearly marked by signage and/or yellow curbs.




# December 4th 2-6:30PM
